- To keep all N.T.R.A members informed and supported in their work, by way of regular enews, the member's area of our website, email helplines and any other means as required.

Membership of the N.T.R.A is available to all Professional Tarot Readers

It is important that all Tarot Readers adhere to the same principles to ensure a consistency of service and quality is supplied.

All members will operate such business in an honest and ethical manner.



CODE OF PRACTICE

- 1) The Tarot Reader will conduct themselves in a professional, ethical and moral manner at all times in accordance with this Code of Practice.
- 2) Members will, as and when required, be prepared to refer a client on to any suitably qualified third party, such as relationship counsellor or doctor. Members must recognise the limitations of offering a Tarot reading service under certain circumstances.
- 3) All N.T.R.A members must deliver their services in a responsible and non-judgemental manner
- 4) Each client must be treated with respect
- 5) All readings are confidential, the contents only to be discussed between N.T.R.A Tarot reader and their client.
- 6) All N.T.R.A members will be covered by Public Liability insurance is carrying out their services in a location other than their own property.
- 7) N.T.R.A member's fees should be in line with normal working practices. The reading fee must be agreed between reader and client before the commencement of the reading.
- 8) Readings will not be given to minors people who appear to be under the age of 18 years of age.
- 9) Should a member feel they have any issues when giving a reading and be unable to complete the service, the reader will treat the client with care and the fee will be refunded to the client.
- 10) All members must abide by the Equality Policy as stated below.
